KEFALONIA ISLAND

Magnificent scenery, amazing beaches, a rich cultural heritage, great monuments, mountains, castles, distant monasteries and the cheerful, hospitable people are the assets that have turned Kefalonia Island into one of the most attractive destinations. The largest Ionian island lies in the mouth of Patraikos Gulf, between Zakynthos and Lefkada. It is endowed with an exquisite nature and diverse geological formations, countless coves, and lush vegetation.

ANTIPAXOS ISLAND

It is a pretty, miniature of an island, southeast of Paxoi (3 nm from Gaios), known for its fantastic beaches. Voutoumi, a beach of exotic beauty, is among the finest in Greece.



IONIAN SEA PAXOS ISLAND

A sanctuary of love for gods. Cultural village of Europe for the year 2004, Paxi (or Paxoi) is the ideal island for a peaceful holiday. Fjord-shaped beaches, underwater caves, small bays and green hills welcome the lucky visitors. According to the legend, the island would be the southernmost tip of Corfu, if the God of the Sea, Poseidon, had not broken it off with his trident when he needed a god-deserving place to live his love with the Nereid Amphitrite.

IONIAN SEA SIVOTA

Most of the people visiting Sivota stay only near beaches. Nevertheless, the rest of the area is also equally interesting. From the south side of the settlement starts a beautiful route which includes the abandoned Vrachona settlement and Polineri village. Because the area is full of rural roads most of the route follows them. Hikers' effort is paid back with the beautiful view of Sivota islets and Corfu in the background.



IONIAN SEA PARGA

Parga is a lovely town on the north western side of Greece, nestled between lush green hills and the clear waters of the Ionian Sea. Although it is a mainland town, its architecture gives a special island vibe. Colorful houses with a breathtaking view of the sea, exotic beaches with turquoise waters and a wonderful natural landscape give the best of impressions to every traveller.

LEFKAS ISLAND

Lefkada or Leucas Island is surrounded by a total of 24 islets (Aristotle Onassis' Skorpis being one of them).

It connects to the opposite coast of Central Greece via a floating swing bridge. On Lefkada you will find noteworthy sights, churches and monasteries, picturesque villages, lush vegetation, idyllic coves of turquoise waters, busy and secluded beaches of stunning beauty, a significant cultural heritage and hospitable locals.

IONIAN SEA SKORPIOS ISLAND

Skorpios is the most famous private island of the Ionian Islands, located on the east side of Lefkada, in front of the village of Nidri. It was a private property of Aristotle Onassis, who transformed it into a "garden of Eden" with beautiful sandy beaches and rare natural wealth. Small bays and beaches with crystal-clear, emerald coloured waters are still closed for the public, and tourists are not allowed to go ashore.

KALAMOS ISLAND

Kalamos is not a conventional island. It is a tall mountain range which floats on the sea, its northern side overgrowing with towering, thick pine trees. It is obvious to even the non-specialist visitor that these pines are of a special species.

ATOKOS ISLAND

Atokos is an uninhabited, privately owned island located in the Ionian Sea, south of Lefkas and north of Ithaca. It is an area of 4 km² with wild beauty, virgin vegetation and several bays, suitable for boats during the summer. In the island, there are two small pebbled beaches accessible only by boat. Common dolphins often appear, along with seals *monachus monachus* who find shelter in the caves of the coastline.



IONIAN SEA ITHACA ISLAND

Famous as the legendary homeplace of Ulysses, Ithaca island is a paradisiacal island for total relaxation. It has amazing lush greenery, gem villages and beaches with blue green waters. Kioni and Vathy are the most picturesque villages, while wonderful beaches to swim are Filiatro, Sarakiniko and Agios Ioannis.
