

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

ionian sea PREVEZA

Capital of the prefecture, built on the entrance of the Gulf of Amvrakikos. A modern city, administrative, commercial, intellectual and tourist center of the prefecture. Beautiful, traditional buildings adorn the port and the historical center while the pedestrian walkways and cobblestone streets lined with popular taverns and cafès remind us of the islands.

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IONIAN SEA PAXOS ISLAND

A sanctuary of love for gods. Cultural village of Europe for the year 2004, Paxi (or Paxoi) is the ideal island for a peaceful holiday. Fjord-shaped beaches, underwater caves, small bays and green hills welcome the lucky visitors. According to the legend, the island would be the southernmost tip of Corfu, if the God of the Sea, Poseidon, had not broken it off with his trident when he needed a god-deserving place to live his love with the Nereid Amphitrite.


IONIAN SEA CORFUISLAND

OTHONOI ISLANDS

Othonoi (Othoni) is a small island of the Ionian sea, close to the north shore of Corfu island. It is the largest inhabited island of the Diapontia group and it is also the remotest of them, constituting the westernmost point of Greece. Othonoi is a getaway destination where you can enjoy very calm and hospitable stay among the friendly locals. The island port called Ammos lies in a wind protected bay and it has a few beaches around the port with soft sand and shallow water. Ammos has developed as the most populous settlement of Othonoi, with restaurants, cafes, mini markets, a few small hotels.

ERIKOUSA ISLAND

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Ereikoussa is the most northern, inhabited island of the Ionia Sea and the second biggest of the Diapondia islands complex. It is a hidden gem and a small paradise where guests can relax and come closer to nature. If you love hiking through green mountain alleys and feel amazed by azure Ionian waters, Ereikoussa should be on your bucket list. The island has two beautiful beaches, Porto, which is the island's main port and Bragini, a quiet sandy beach. Although a small island (just 4,5 sq.km) you may find plenty of choices for food and entertainment.

IONIAN SEA SIVOTA

Most of the people visiting Sivota stay only near beaches. Nevertheless, the rest of the area is also equally interesting. From the south side of the settlement starts a beautiful route which includes the abandoned Vrachona settlement and Polineri village. Because the area is full of rural roads most of the route follows them. Hikers' effort is paid back with the beautiful view of Sivota islets and Corfu in the background.

IONIAN SEA PARGA

Parga is a lovely town on the north western side of Greece, nested between lush green hills and the clear waters of the Ionian Sea. Although it is a mainland town, its architecture gives a special island vibe. Colorful houses with a breathtaking view of the sea, exotic beaches with turquoise waters and a wonderful natural landscape give the best of impressions to every traveller.





LEFKAS ISLAND

Lefkada or Leucas Island is surrounded by a total of 24 islets (Aristotle Onassis' Skorpios being one of them). It connects to the opposite coast of Central Greece via a floating swing bridge. On Lefkada you will find noteworthy sights, churches and monasteries, picturesque villages, lush vegetation, idyllic coves of turquoise waters, busy and secluded beaches of stunning beauty, a significant cultural heritage and hospitable locals.
