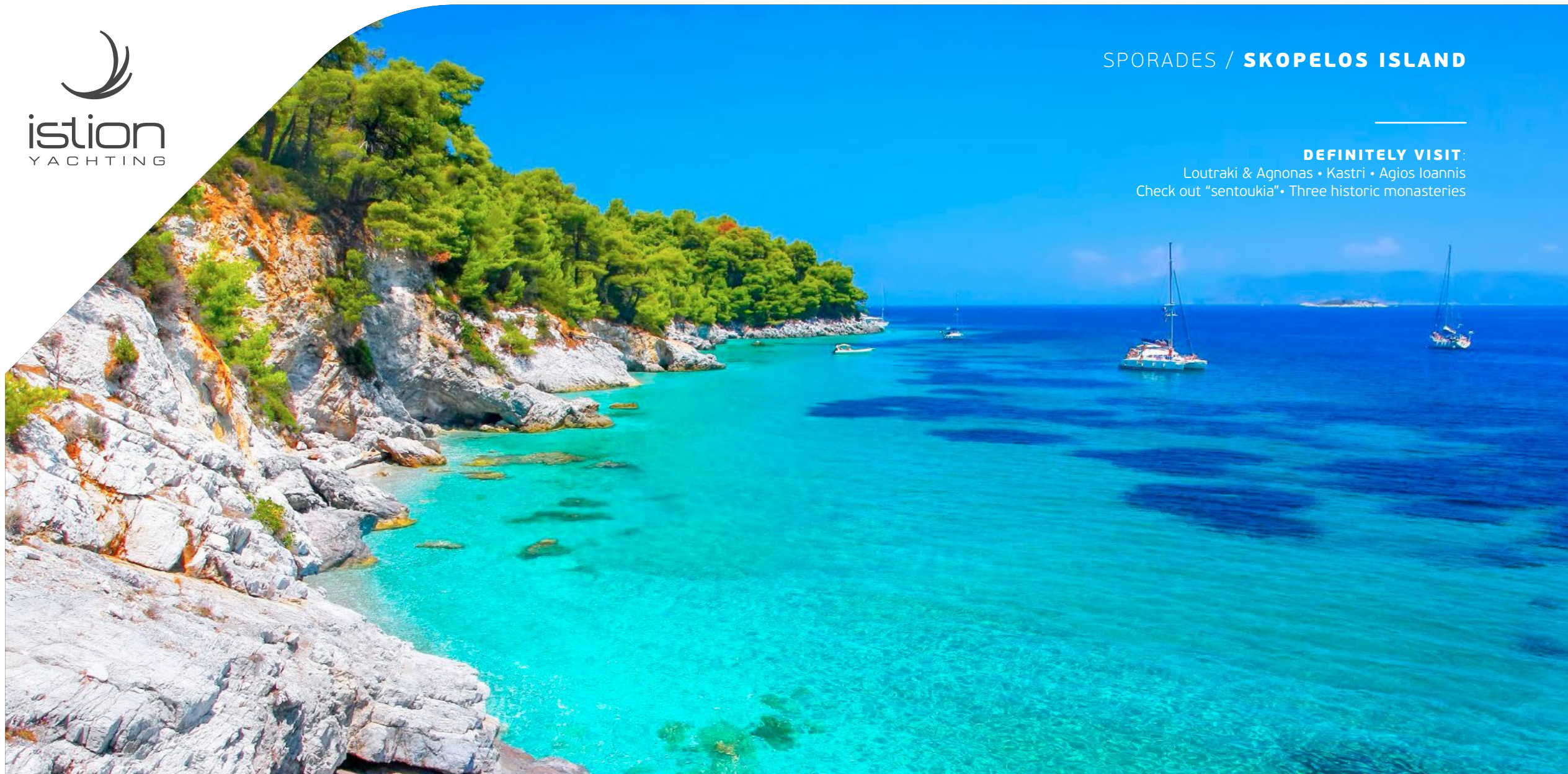
SKOPELOS ISLAND

ALONISSOS ISLAND

Alonissos is an authentic island mostly known for its incredible natural beauty and the amazing beaches. Chora is the most picturesque village in Alonissos island, located on top of a hill and offering great view to the Aegean Sea. The beaches are crystal and surrounded by lush greenery, creating a relaxing atmosphere.

PERISTERA ISLAND

Peristera is an uninhabited island part of the national marine park of Alonissos. It is the ideal anchoring point for someone that wants to relax under the sun avoiding the crowded beaches of Alonissos. The island can only be reached from Alonissos with a brief navigation from the ports of Steni Vala or Agios Dimitros. At Peristera is prohibited to use oxygen tanks diving or to take any sponges from the seabed. Fishing is also prohibited at least 1,5 mile from the island's coast.

KYRA PANAGIA ISLAND

The island of Kyra Panagia is largest deserted island north of Alonissos. The island is mostly covered in low shrubs and vegetation, but there are also some olive trees. Excavations of ruins in the bay of Agios Petros opposite the islet of Melissa, have shown that it has been inhabited since the Neolithic times, in about 6,000 B.C



S P O R A D E S

SKATZOURA ISLAND

Skantzoura is the southernmost island of the Northern Sporades archipelago and important for the conservation of the natural wildlife of Alonissos national marine park. Skantzoura was once home to the orthodox monks of Mt. Athos; nowadays is the ideal place for spotting endangered species of birds like the Eleonora's hawk and Audouin's seagull. If you are lucky enough you may even spot some monk seals, another endangered species of the Mediterranean sea, and of course dolphins.

S P O R A D E S SKYROS ISLAND

Skyros is a small island that belongs to the Sporades complex, along with Skiathos, Skopelos, and Alonissos. Skyros reserves countless spots where you can enjoy relaxation and stunning views of the sea. The northern side of Skyros distinguishes for its greenery, the pine forests, and the rocky beaches. Most of the activities on Skyros concentrate in Chora. The rest settlements all over the island come alive in summer only. On the northernmost spot of Skyros, there is a small airport.

PAGASETIC GULF
PSAROPOULI

Psaropouli is a perfect summer destination located in the Artemisio municipality, near the northernmost point of eastern Evia. With its 4 kilometers long shoreline, featuring sandy and pebbly beaches, clear waters, and a rich seabed, it is a must-visit destination. Despite its small size, the village's picturesque stone houses and hospitable residents make it incredibly charming. You can enjoy delicious food at the beachfront taverns and restaurants that offer breathtaking views of the sea.



PAGASETIC GULF
OREOI

Nestled along the enchanting landscapes of northern Evia, Oreoi Village is a captivating haven brimming with cultural richness and natural beauty. The settlement is famous for the fresh fish served by its small taverns and ouzeries. A picturesque small port, some cafeterias and taverns with joyful people compose heartfelt atmosphere. There is an organized beach on the left side of the small port, for those who'd like to have a swim.



PAGASETIC GULF PALEO TRIKERI

The island, located on a ridge on the southern arm of Pelion, is one of Greece's undiscovered gems. It is so small, that within 2-3 hours of walking through hillsides covered in thyme and juniper to deserted beaches and coves, you can see all of it. Only about 20 people live here full time. There are no roads, and no cars, transport is on foot or by mule.

It is also completely flat. Its highest peak is 129 meters, where the fortress-like Evangelistria Monastery, a place of interest worth visiting, is located. The beaches are few but charming, with turquoise crystal-clear waters. Locals refer to them as Afetka, Hagia Sophia and Prasini Ammos, all close to each other. Besides the picturesque view, local taverns can offer you a classic traditional Magnesian meal with tsipouro or wine.



PAGASETIC GULF AFISSOS

Afissos is a lovely summer resort about 25 km from Volos. It is geographically found on the southern side of Mount Pelion, built amphitheatrically with view to the Pagasetic Gulf. This fishing village has developed a bit over the last years with delicious taverns at the port and family hotels, but it hasn't lost at all the traditional charm. Surrounded by lush greenery and many sandy beaches, Afissos is a nice family place and an ideal base for excursions in the southern side of Pelion.



PAGASETIC GULF
VOLOS CITY

Located in central Greece, under the shadow of mountain Pelion, Volos is a city of ancient myths and history. Its port is where our quest begins as modern Argonauts, seeking the freedom of sailing. By the seaside of Volos Port there are numerous café-bars and restaurants, where you can enjoy your time before you set sails with your yacht. In traditional restaurants, known as "Tsipouradiko/Ouzeri", you can enjoy the local culinary experience, "tsipouro" with "meze". There are many options for you to enjoy your evening, pleasing anyone's appetite or the desire of an intense nightlife.

PAGASETIC GULF
AMALIAPOLI

Amaliapoli (named after former Queen Amalia of Greece), or Mitzela as locals call it, is a charming little village inside the Pagasitikos Gulf. There are taverns where you can enjoy fresh seafood and dishes of the local cuisine, and beach bars on the organized beach where you can enjoy coffee or cocktails. Don't miss the sunset from Loutraki Bay and the lovely view from the church's terrace. Across the seaside lies the small island of Kikinthos, hosting only the small chapel of Aghia Marina. Small bays, clear-watered beaches accessible by boat and the Underwater Shipwreck Museum Diving Park are awaiting to be explored.
